#### **Spitfire Presentation.**

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June 7.30pm

Our Heritage group have organised an illustrated talk on the spitfire the world's best-known fighter from World War II. Looking at its origins, production and development, set against the Southampton Blitz and the Battle of Britain. The Spitfire took its first test flight from Southampton Airport 74 years ago and there are further local links with the Supermarine Works.

The talk is by Colin Van Geffen a self-employed illustrator and artist. Colin is a founder member of the Solent Aviation Art Society who also helps to run the Aviation Museum in Southampton.
